EDITORIAL

First of all, there are 75 regions of PCA and we already exchange newsletters with several, but if we have any news or articles worthy of universal attention, doesn't Panorama serve its proper function by publishing such material? Why duplicate a national publication? Most of the newsletters, with a few notable exceptions, are chatty little papers filled with items of interest solely to local memberships. Just change the names and you'd swear they were run from the same stencils. Once in a while some fresh material does appear, but, like ripples in a pond, it re-appears in subsequent issues of other regions until it has circulated throughout the country. Every member of PCA reads Pano and since we all send newsletters to at least three departments of that publication, why inundate some poor regional official's wastebasket with 75 newsletters? Who in the region has time to read 75 newsletters? So far I haven't mentioned cost, but the subsidy to each region is to be \$100.00, once, flat and for all. Our publication and postage cost would probably allow us to ride free on this for a year or so but what of the regions who put out a magazine format that costs 16¢ or so to mail and God knows how much per copy to publish. I hate to display a negative attitude, but all that printing, folding, stamping, stapling, addressing, over and above our regular mailing really defeats me, especially when I know we are only decorating the interior of about 70 wastebaskets.

I feel confident that P.C.A. could put the necessary \$7500.00 required for this project to better use -- maybe hire someone to glean articles from the newsletters that might improve Panorama.
