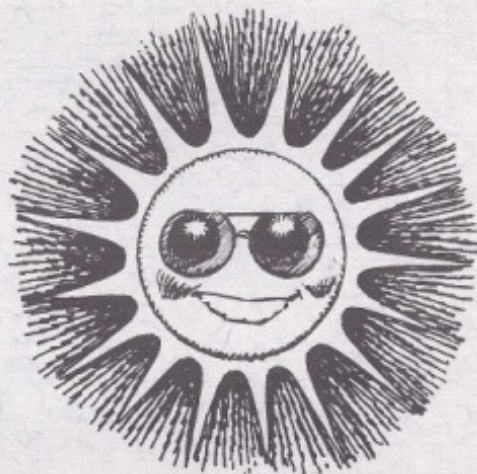
The perfect summer day...
