# This is an event you don't want to miss!

Here's some answers to the most frequently asked questions about our Driver Education event at Indianapolis Raceway Park this July.

- GENERAL A limited number of cars will be accepted so apply soon. The
  Driver Ed is a 2-day event and will be run similar to last year. Those who
  register for the Driver Ed will receive a confirmation packet in the mail which
  will cover event rules, passing procedures, tech, hotels, etc.
- RUN GROUPS Although the Driver Ed will take place on the same days as
  the club race, drivers registered for the club race will not be on the track at the
  same time as students. These groups will take turns using the track according
  to the event schedule. Students will have multiple driving sessions each day
  which average about 25 minutes each session.
- HELMETS You'll need a helmet which is rated Snell 90 SA or Snell 95 SA. A
  motorcycle helmet with only a DOT rating will not be accepted. Fold back the
  padding to read the rating sticker (do not remove the sticker). If you're buying
  a new helmet, a model with full-face protection is recommended. It's a little
  more money but as they say, "If you have a ten dollar head, buy a ten dollar
  helmet."
- 4. ROLL BARS Hard top coupes, Targas and 914s are not required to have a roll bar. If your car will be running with a <u>soft top</u> or without a top, it must have a good quality roll bar, which is higher than the driver's helmet. To check yours, sit in the car while wearing your seatbelt and helmet. Have someone hold a broomstick so it rests upon the top of the roll bar and the top of the windshield. There should be 2 inches of air between the broomstick and your helmet. If you discover that you are too tall for your Boxster's roll bar, you can buy an after-market extension unit made specifically to remedy this problem. Lowering the seat may also be an option.
- EXPERIENCE You'll need to know some basic car control techniques and safety rules before participating in this event. Therefore, 4 days of prior Driver Ed experience is required and must include time driving without an instructor in the car. Experience other than PCA will be considered by case.
- RACING Driver Education is high performance driving. However, it is not racing nor is it a racing school. If you want to race, you must enter the PCA club race which will require a PCA racing license.

Hope this answered your questions. Have fun and we'll see you at the track!
