- Corner workers - act as an extra set of eyes and ears working alongside an experienced corner flagger. Best "seats" in the house, close to the action. 7am to 5 PM Sat & Sunday
- Timing and Scoring - Highly coveted positions as they are located in the air-conditioned tower on the front straight. Positions include "runners" to copy and distribute practice session/race results, and "tapers" who serve as a back-up to the electronic timing a scoring. Hours: 7-5 Sat and Sunday
- Registration - Work under the "big top", distribute race packets, check race licenses, insure waivers are signed etc. Friday afternoon and Saturday morning hours.
- Scrutineer Assistants - Helps PCA National Scrutineer with racer technical inspection line, check log books. Friday afternoon, Saturday morning hours.
