

## The Way It Was

TWENTY YEARS AGO The May 1983 CIRcular recommended everyone meet at IN37 and I465 for a tour to French Lick and then a ride on the train operated by the Indiana Railroad Museum. I won-

### TEN YEARS AGO

The May 1993 CIRcular listed a Fathers' Day brunch and Concours at the Garden On the Green at the Indianapolis Art Museum. As I remember, Judy and I and Bill Marsh and friend neglected to make reservations, so when we arrived, "there was no room at the inn".

## AND MORE.....

About an hour ago Judy and I returned from Hershey PA and the giant Porsche Swap Meet. By the time you read this you may not remember, but we had a beautiful sunny day for the trip to Hershey on Friday. We also had a beautiful sunny day for the trip home on Sunday. But on Saturday, the day of the Swap Meet, it rained almost the entire day. We've attended this swap meet for probably 15 or more years and rain has often made an appearance. In the past, I've always gone with the intent of purchasing things that I felt I couldn't do without. This year was just the opposite... I went to sell things that I no longer need since selling the '58 Coupe plus get rid of excess inventory of parts from cars I stripped out over the years. The event is as much social as business....seeing Porsche friends from all over. Two friends from the Netherlands came by our space and we had a brief visit. We figured out a way to operate in the rain. Our Honda Odyssey van's rear door is hinged at the top so we opened it and draped a tarp over it to provide a small "room" at the rear of the van. I made a couple of posters listing the more important items I wanted to sell and it worked out pretty well. Of course it would have been a lot better if we'd been able to set up our tables and spread things out on display but in the circumstances we faced, we came out pretty well. Someone would ask about a such and such that I had listed and then I'd have to dig through the boxes and milk crates to find the item. The Hershey Swap Meet is held on the grounds of Hershey Park and it's almost mandatory that after the swap meet, you go to the Hershey Chocolate Outlet Store and load up on things for the sweet tooth. Ironically, the prices are usually higher than you pay at the stores at home. One friend told us that his wife always reminded him to bring her some chocolate goodies. After he learned that the pricing was at a premium, he stopped at a grocery or other on the way home and got the same stuff. She was always impressed with his remembrances although she didn't know the source. There are three reasonably close swap meets coming up in June and July: Tweeks in Effingham, IL, Stoddard's near Cleveland and at the Kruse Museum in Auburn IN. I hope I can really move a lot more of the things from the basement and garage shelves at those events. One problem I have is finding time to clean things so they will be more presentable and hopefully bring higher prices.

Will these pages be cited ten or twenty years from now? Will I really be rid of all of the excess parts by then? Stick around!



## **USGP FAN APPRECIATION DAY**




