



<u>Ultimate multi-purpose vehicle</u>

Our 1976 912E is the ultimate multi-purpose vehicle.

Being such it is used in its primary role as daily driver. It is used as a great platform for instruction at our club Performance Driver Ed's. And it is used as "Toad" being pulled behind our motor home to Florida and various other parts of the US.

For those who are not familiar with the 912 model series, these cars were basically the same as the 911 only with a 4 cylinder engine. They were produced from 1965 to 1969, and then brought back as the 912E for the 1976 model year.

As with other Porsche models, the 912 is a great daily driver. Fun to drive, easy on gas, and the best part, it's a Porsche! Doing our Color Tours and other social drives are a blast, while even running mundane errands are better in the 912.

In the roll as instruction platform, the 912 is quiet enough and soft enough to provide a great seat for learning. The car only has 78 horse power, so my students never need to worry

about being scared by neck snapping acceleration!!! But having said that, the car is only a 912 on the straights, it's a 911 in the corners. I have driven the car on track at Putnam Park, Gingerman, Mid Ohio Sports Car Course, Sebring, and Blackhawk Farms just for fun.


The car is fantastic in its role as "Toad". Since it only weighs about 2100 pounds, the motor home does not even know it's there. In numerous trips to Florida, motor home fuel mileage is exactly the same with or without the

912. It just rolls along behind the Airstream hiding in its wake. We even have Thule roof rack to carry our beach bikes on the roof! Once in Florida, there is nothing like having the car with us back in its roll of daily driver.


These cars are meant to be used and driven, and I do my best to use it and drive it as much as possible!

However, with time, I got a little better with each session, thanks to Tim. Another big thanks goes to Rob Fike for taking the time to drive my car, with me as a passenger, and give me some tips on handling and what lines work well for my car. Not too surprisingly, the lines were nearly identical to the lines that Tim had been suggesting. It's always good to get another set of eyes and opinion. Thank you Rob.

What did I expect? After listening to the stories and experiences from some of the others that have driven in previous DE's and the encouragement from George Barker to "try one", my experience was pretty close to what I had expected. The Devil is in the details, and it is so true on the track. The details are what I am, and will be, more aware of in my day-to-day driving. My driving habits probably won't change too much however, they will be refined each time I drive.

Will I come back? I certainly hope so. I will ask "she who must be obeyed" if I can slip away for another weekend next spring to fall in love with my, hot little sweet singing mistress once again....she knows what I like!

This year we are going to the hottest new place in downtown Cincinnati – the brand new **Christian Moerlein Lager House**, which is opening Feb. 27 in the new Smale Riverfront Park next door to the Great American Ballpark, where the Reds play! Located along the Ohio River and within view of the John Roebling Suspension Bridge and across the river from where we stay overnight, this is <u>the</u> <u>place to be</u> in downtown Cincy and we are going to be there just 2 months after it opens!



Christian Moerlein is one of the oldest and largest brewers in Cincinnati (and the U. S.!) and they were selected to be the anchor restaurant and microbrewery for this prestigious new site. All their many famous craft brews will be on tap and the food menu is being created by the same people in Indy that brought us the award-winning Stone Creek Dining and Boulder Creek Dining establishments around Indy. Delectable fare featuring freshly baked breads from spent brewer's grain, hand carved sandwiches and smoked rotisserie meats - foods reminiscent of those served in the city's celebrated 19th century beer gardens, are just a sampling of what is in store for us. The building is state-of-the-art architecture with breathtaking views of everything. Seating 500 patrons inside and another 600 outside in the Biergartens, this is a huge place! We will arrive by 5:30 PM and have reserved group seating in the Main Dining Rooms. Parking is available in a pay (\$8) garage underneath the restaurant with direct elevator service.

Again we have reserved a block of 10 King Bedtype rooms with Ohio River Views at \$139/night under the "Porsche Club" Group Rate, that include the Sunday morning Breakfast Buffet at the fabu-


