We have a wonderful mix of events this month. And as always, please go to the website to get all the information on each event.


On the 7th we have our "First Saturday Breakfast" at the Paragon Restaurant. They are on the west side at 10th and Girls School Road.

Every type of food is covered and the big problem is which tempting selection do you choose? Then there are the beer menus. I've never seen so many bottled beer options and the draft beer menu has not even been posted yet at this writing! Wow, we are in for a gastronomical treat! Our group reservations are for 5:30 PM and I have asked for a window view of the Ohio River and the John Roebling Suspension Bridge. This is shaping up to be a dinner to remember.

We are meeting as al-ways for the Start in Morristown, IN (19



miles or ½ hr. east of I-465 on US 52) in the center of town, just behind the Shelby County (soon to be First Merchants) Bank on the south side of the Main Street thru town at **Noon** for Registration and handout of route instructions. Performance Driver Ed; At It's Best – In The Rain! - Randy Faunce

Performance driver education is about smoothness – gentle squeezing of the foot pedals, gradual increasing and relaxing of steering input, soft shifting of the gearbox. PDE is about car control keeping the four footprints as balanced as possible, rounding off the track corners to the longest radius possible to minimize body roll. PDE is about enhancing recovery skills - feeling where the car wants to go, and which end wants to get there first, knowing when the balance of those four friction pads (tires) has been upset, and how to calmly restore that balance.

Sure, PDE is also about FUN! And lateral Gforces, and fast straights, and wind in the cockpit. But none of that is as exhilarating if there is no smoothness, if there is no control.

The very best teacher of that control and driving gentility is experience behind the wheel while piloting along a slick, wet track. That's right, performance driver education is most educational when it's raining! Quick jerks on the steering wheel, hard

stomps on the pedals, rough shifts will NOT be tolerated by your car on a wet surface (hmmm, could be why they water down the skip pads for training purposes?).

In the rain. your control inputs MUST be smooth and gentle. Of course, you won't



have the speedometer running as high as you will when it's dry, but that also means reduced speed consequences if you make a mistake, PLUS more time to complete the recovery attempt before the edge of the pavement is breached.

It's so easy to fall into a number of bad habits running session after session on a hot, dry track – one good session in the rain will break those bad habits and retrain the good, smooth, safe, and FAST ones.

While many of my experienced driving buddies will sit and watch the rain fall when their run group is called, you'll find my car, out on track, pushing the limits, lap after lap (Hoosiers replaced with OEM street (very capable rain) tires). Just 45 minutes of forced smooth driving, and I'll retain that smoothness when the track dries out, and be that much quicker because of it. So an entire afternoon full of




After a leisurely tour of the Gilmore collections, those who can stay for Day 2 will continue to Grand Rapids for dinner at the Man-

<u>Teen Driver Emergency Car Control Clinic — Randy Faunce, Driver Ed Director, CIRPCA (Dr.Faunce@ProTempInd.com)</u>

INDIANAPOLIS - Congratulations on your (or your child's) passing of the Indiana BMV exams to earn your driver's license! It means you know enough of the 'rules of the road' (use of signals, road signs, which lane to be in, 4-way stops, etc.) to NOT be a hazard to the others on the road with you.


A couple questions for you: do you know what the foot pedal is supposed to feel like on really hard braking? Can you keep your car from spinning into a tree if you have to suddenly swerve around an obstacle? On wet pavement?

We're hosting a Car Control Clinic, specifically designed for newer drivers (age 21 and under), to share the knowledge (classroom) and experience (driving drills) needed to enhance safety during emergency driving maneuvers (skills not taught in traditional driver's education). It's NOT about speed (no helmets), or timed performance (no trophies), or 'drifting', or... It's an open parking lot, with traffic cones, specifically set up to experience an emergency

lane change, or skidding on wet pavement, or what to do on a brake-and-turn (and what NOT to do, too).

The drills will be performed in the driver's daily driven car, with an experienced instructor in the passenger seat, offering driving tips and techniques that are reinforced during the classroom sessions.

The program was developed by Street Survival, an independent foundation established for the purpose of teen driving safety enhancement.
