
As I think about my love for driving, I'm struck with the notion that perhaps this could be the root of our inability to get the vast majority of you, our members to partake in any of our club activities.

Team Falken Tire —

2012 is the third full season of competition for Team Falken Tire in the American Le Mans Series. Named by SPEED as one of the breakout teams of 2011, Team Falken Tire clinched their maiden win at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course after expert driving combined with Falken Tires, outperformed the field in the treacherous conditions. Managed by Derrick Walker, the race team finished the 2011 season in fourth in the GT Team Championship and fifth in the GT Drivers' Championship.



Wolf Henzler

Falken Tire could not be happier to have the Nurtingen, Germany native back on the roster for 2012. Having brought the Falken shod Porsche 911 GT3 RSR across to the checker for Falken's first ALMS GT win, Henzler showcased his car control capabilities piloting the race car through a torrential downpour that left other competitors off track and off pace. His aggressive driving style was most famously noticed in 2011 during his "thread the needle" YouTube hit at Road America. Having multiple Series wins on his resume and winning the overall GT2 Championship as recently as 2008, Wolf brings world renowned success and experience to Team Falken Tire which will be running the new 2012 version of the Porsche 911 GT3 RSR in competition. Wolf again returns to Falken as a Porsche works driver, making him one of nine drivers to hold the

honor in the world. When not driving, Wolf spends his time mountain biking, skiing, golfing and working on his personal fitness to help him endure the grueling long distance





races that are a signature element of the American Le Mans Series.

Bryan Sellers

Falken Tire's sophomore championship campaign in the American Le Mans Series, highlighted by wins at both Mid-Ohio in a torrential downpour and the inaugural Baltimore Grand Prix street course, would not have been successful without Bryan Sellers. The young American is making his presence known in the world of GT Sports Car Racing and looks to build on his momentum in 2012. Sellers' role in the development of Falken's Azenis RT-Slick has been extremely critical with his precise realworld feedback to the tire and chassis engineers, both in the United States and Japan. Having competed in many forms of racing including go-karting and in his younger years. open wheel racing and most recently sports car racing, Sellers' resume is extensive. Bryan's reputation for his ability to absorb knowledge and a high level of professionalism combined with his skills behind the wheel make him a perfect drier candidate for Falken Tire. Born in Dayton, OH, Sellers now finds himself a stone's throw away from world renowned Road Atlanta in Braselton, GA, home of the season finale Petit Le Mans. When asked to describe his mo-

tivation for his racing career, Sellers refers to his favorite quote, "Winners don't wait for chances, they make them."

The result was perhaps the lowest-sitting cars ever seen in this type of racing. Teo Fabi, who had finished 4th in the previous year's point standings for this team, was unable to duplicate his successes, but did finish 3rd over the Meadowlands, New Jersey street course, and won the pole at Denver. Teammate John Andretti finished 10th in points with six finishes of 7th or higher, including a pair of 5th-place finishes.


