
We had 295 PCA members and their guests at the Indy GRAND-AM PCA Suite for lunch and 127 Porsches in the Porsche Car Corral.

The Grand-Am race was a new event at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, and it is great to see the historic facility used for another race. I did hear some driver complaints about how tight the road course is, but those complaints were not from the podium finishers! I think that a part of it is that this is a new course for the Grand-Am circuit and it will take drivers awhile to learn its nuances.

It really was a great race from a strategy standpoint, as the alternating periods of wet and dry challenged both drivers and pit crews. And the cars did slow down in the rain, but for the trailing cars, the visibility has to be terrible. This is one of the things I like about Grand-Am, it really is "no excuses...rain or shine" racing.

Since this was the same weekend as the Brickyard 400, there were a lot of NASCAR fans at this event. And this gave them a chance to see a different style of racing featuring cars that are much truer to stock than anything Sprint Cup offers and cars that can also turn right! (See how innovations just abound in Grand-Am!??!)

The other aspect of the Grand-Am is that some Sprint Cup drivers were able to participate; and some did.

Juan Pablo Montoya for one jumped at the chance to alienate fans and drivers in another series, with a style of driving that has earned him tens of fans and hundreds of bitter enemies.

The Mazda's looked very strong in qualifications, but the Magnus Racing GT3 was able to bring home the GT victory. That really shows how that team was able to adapt to the changing conditions, and prevail.

During the Q&A with Jens (Yens) Walther, Pres. & CEO of Porsche Motorsports North America, he was asked if Porsche was looking at a mid engined car. He talked about this for a few minutes, but here is the



summary. He said, Why would they?" and then he commented that getting the right balance was difficult, and it was difficult to get the front spec tires to heat up, but the 911 was evolving and the engine was effectively moving forward a bit.

Jens also talked about the 3.8 and 4.0 engines and definitely felt the 911 would do some great racing, and they certainly did.

So there are some other great events coming up. The Children's Wish fund event at Ricks Boatyard should be a lot of fun, and it helps a great cause. That will be a great weekend in Indy as the Red Bull Moto GP will be taking place at IMS that weekend as well. So it will be a great weekend to spend in Indy (and show off my new Cayenne GTS!)

There is also the "Adopt-a-Highway" event. This is a great way too show people how we give back to the community. So check the calendar and participate in some of these events.

But as these are the dog days, I think I will try to catch the Dutch Field Hockey team in the Olympics and stick some pins in my Juan Pablo Montoya doll.;-) Happy Motoring!

Brumos to offer special edition Porsche 911 GT3 Cup racer

The Brumos Racing Porsche 911 GT3 Cup racer is not only very good at getting around a track, it's very good at getting to the checkered flag in first place. To celebrate the team's 50-plusyear history and winning last year's Rolex Grand-Am championship, Brumos, in conjunction with Porsche, is offering prepping the final five U.S.-spec 2012 911 GT3 Cup cars just like its racers.



The means a 4.0-liter flat-six with more torque and more than 450 horsepower, a Motec data acquisition system, carbon interior bits, a front debris screen, a rev-blipping system for better downshifts and new brake and steering sensors. It will be finished in the white-with-twin-stripes Brumos livery, and offered for \$265,259 plus tax for five fortunate buyers. That price will also get owners to a handover ceremony and dinner at Porsche Motorsport North America with Brumos Racing vice president Hurley Haywood and drivers Leh Keen and Andrew Davis.

The cars will be eligible for various domestic racing series.



Right Stripes: Porsche 918 Spyder Painted in Full-Color Martini Racing Scheme - from Motor Trend

Porsche released this batch of photos today showing a 918 Spyder painted in the same Martini scheme, but this time with its stripes painted in the traditional Martini colors of red, navy blue, and cerulean. It's not the first time we've seen a 918 painted in a historic 917 racing scheme (earlier press photos showed one painted like the #3 car entered in the 1970 Daytona 24 Hours race), but there's just something about seeing the Martini colors applied to the 918's sinewy form that captures our imagination. We're already having flashbacks to the #22 917 LH that won the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1971.



Porsche's mum on that vehicle, but does note in its release that a 'Ring lap time of "under 7:22" has been a longstanding goal in the 918's development.

Porsche does note that 918 development has entered the next phase, though it doesn't detail exactly what that entails.

Production is supposed to start on September 18 (9/18, get it?) of 2013. We can only hope Porsche replicates some of these liveries on actual production 918 Spyders, just as Ford replicated the JW Auto Gulf livery for the Ford GT. Perhaps Porsche's note on how it's established an agreement with Bacardi & Company to make the Martini livery "exclusively available to the 918 Spyder" is but a hint of things to come, or perhaps it's a hint at who may sponsor Porsche's future return to Le Mans. Stay tuned...


