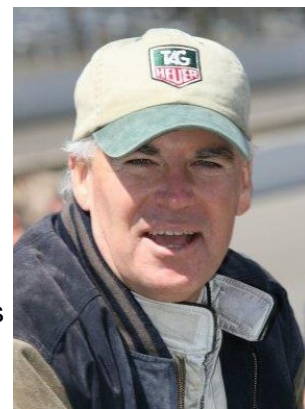
I think I just may have to host an event where we have a fire, roast hot dogs, and marshmallows! Keep checking the calendar.

We have had some great events. And I have brought my new Cayenne out to a few. So I thought I would tell you a little about it and my purchasing thought process.

Many years ago, I had a Lexus RX300. It led to my purchase of a BMW X5. The X5 had much better performance than the RX. But the RX was roomier and had more creature comfort amenities. People warned me the BMW would ride like a truck, but as the previous owner of a Ford F250HD, I was not too worried about that.

So the BMW started getting a bit old. And I had seen, at Porsche events and various other outings, the Cayenne. The Cayenne seemed to have a lot going for it, both in the way of performance and creature comforts.

One of the things that really sold me on the Cayenne was talking to some Cayenne owners at the Savannah Porsche Parade. Specifically shortly after the Autocross. I looked at my times, and then I looked at the Cayenne times and wow, they were quite, and since the autocross course had a slalom, I knew that the Cayenne had to be quite stable at speed.

The owners I spoke to spoke very highly of the air suspension and sport handling features...really left me with some food for thought.

So given my frugal nature, I started hunting for a deal. Initially I found an interesting 2008 Cayenne Turbo on line. It had a nice mix of features and I liked the appearance...and of course there is that 500 HP! But alas that deal was not to close.

Then I had Scott Brooks at O'Daniel Porsche send me an e-mail about a Cayenne GTS they had. The GTS, being a GTS has some great features standard, and this was a 2009.

So, when it came time to get my Boxster

serviced, I asked if the Cayenne GTS was available as a loaner.

So, I had the opportunity to enjoy the GTS for a day. At the end of that day I was pretty much sold. At 405 HP the GTS is not slouch and with 21 inch wheels and Pirelli P Zero tires, it handled like a dream. The GTS typically comes with 21 inch wheels, that is normally an option on the Turbo. Big point for the GTS since wheels mean a lot to me.) It had a great navigation system, satellite radio. The Cayenne has a series of buttons for differential lock, suspension (sport to soft) and ride height. These really let you adapt the vehicle for the specific driving conditions and your personal tastes.

OK, so Now I had to take it back...and time to see if I can make a deal. Many people dread this, but Scott at O'Daniels was great. There was none of the usual car dealer haggling were there sit you in a small office....fed you coffee...tell you the men's room key is lost and their manager will fire him for even suggesting my price. In sum it was a very straightforward experience with Scott at O'Daniels.

So now I have a vehicle with both a lot of comforts, and tremendous handling and performance. Look for it at a Porsche event soon!

Art, Graphics & Design – Hanns Lohrer & Porsche **- from PCA**

4 November 2012, the Porsche Museum is exhibiting the works of the versatile Stuttgart painter and commercial graphic designer Hanns Lohrer (1912 – 1995) – and these works extend far beyond the topic of motor cars. During the 1950s and 60s, Lohrer played a pivotal role in the visual appearance of the Porsche brand which was founded in 1948. In this special exhibition the Porsche Museum pays testimony to the timeless quality of Lohrer's works.

A selection of victory posters created by Hanns Lohrer at the close of every year to visually capture Porsche's sporting successes is one area of focus at the exhibition. A high point within Porsche advertising is, among other things, the series of posters designed by Hanns Lohrer in 1961 depicting the Porsche 356 in the context of sports such as golfing, hunting or horse riding.



In addition to the 40 posters, the Porsche Museum exhibition also includes sales brochure artwork by Hanns Lohrer. Visitors can thus view the red cover page of the 1958 356A catalogue showing a woman's hand wearing an elegant glove and handling the gear shift of a Porsche with seeming effortlessness; giving the headline "Powerful elegance guided with ease" a second visual meaning.

Stuttgart artist Hanns Lohrer has always thrilled those who experience his work and continues to be an inspiration to advertising professionals.

The Porsche Museum is open Tuesday through Sunday from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Admission is € 8.00 for adults, reduced admission is € 4.00.

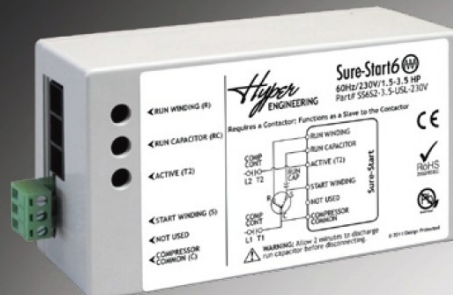

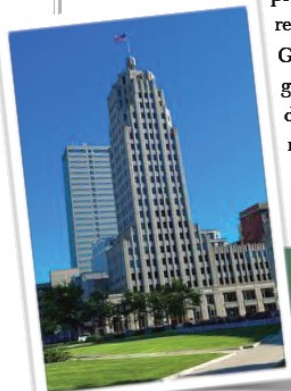
