Of course we have the Huber Winery Tour coming up on the 20th, but there is no reason to wait until then to get out and drive.





You get typically 5 runs and those are timed.

It turns out he had just bought it a few days prior and decided to bring it out and autocross it. I asked why he picked a 944, and he said he was looking for a moderately prices car that he could restore. It is quite a testament to Porsche automobiles that the person would buy a 944 turbo (an old-





er vehicle) and then a few days later run it in an autocross, a testament to both car and driver.

Hopefully I will see these people (and some of you as well) at future autocross events. The driving season is waning and there is a chill in the air, but this is one of the best times of the year for the more social events like the Saturday breakfasts and the Destination dinner drive mentioned below. By going to different events you meet different people and it gives you a chance to meet more of the great people in our club.


National Auto & Truck Museum, Auburn, IN (2nd Saturday breakfast & museum tour and more!) Saturday, November 10th - Debbie Groulik
