






No track experience is necessary, and no helmets. You will have pace cars to hold the speeds to

## 2013 Spring Brake Driver Ed and Wounded Warrior Track Rides

#### 2013 DE Overview

Central Indiana Region PCA hosts High Performance Driver Education events at Putnam Park Road Course in Mt. Meridian, Indiana. Putnam Park was built in 1991 and Central Indiana Region PCA was one of the first groups to utilize the excellent circuit for high performance driver education and club racing events.

For those who may not be quite ready for the DE experience, we will be offering our Intro to DE program. The program offers those interested in doing DE a chance to see what it's all about. You'll get the classroom experience and be able to ride with some of our experienced instructors. The Intro to DE program does require the use of a



SA2005 or later helmet. A limited number of helmets may be available for rent at the track on a first come, first served basis. Enrollment for the Intro to DE experience is explained in detail below.

For our instructors and those drivers with lots of track time (Groups A and B) we'll be offering our Friday Lapping Day. Lunch is included for all participants on Friday prepared by the CIR pit crew.

Putnam Park is 40 miles west of Indianapolis, just off I-70 near Cloverdale. While we generally have good weather, we do ask that you come prepared for the best and worst Indiana can offer.

We are looking forward to a great weekend of per-



formance driving and sharing good times with old and new friends.

Less experienced drivers will have an instructor riding with them on-track until the driver is comfortable with the course and the car.

There will be four run groups and an instructor group to better match students of similar abilities in the same session. Run Group A will be for very experienced drivers in higher performance cars.

Group B will be for experienced drivers new to Putnam Park or driving medium performance cars.

Group C will be for student drivers with some experience and Group D will be for student drivers with little or no experience. There will also be scheduled classroom instruction/discussion sessions to discuss aspects of high performance driv-



ing with plenty of time for questions and answers. This is an excellent time to learn more about your car's capabilities and enhance your driving Join us for a great weekend of "unwipeable" smiles and become a better driver on and off the track.

The Event headquarters will be the spectacular Cambria Suites. Cambria Suites is located at 6014 Gateway Drive, Plainfield, IN 46168 (317) 279-2394. The Cambria Suites offers a wonderful lodging experience while offering a top notch restaurant and bar within the hotel. ## **Porsche Parade Primer II**

#### Last Issue

Last issue (1st Quarter, 2013), I covered the basics of what a Porsche Parade is all about, with info on registration, competitive events, banquets, family events, hotel, do's and don'ts, etc. – just enough to get you interested in registering. To date, 18 CIR member's cars are now registered with about 36 of our members attending. This has to be a Parade record for our region!

#### **CIR Parade Sign-Up**

Are you registered for the Parade? Do you plan on going for even one day? We would like to know and so would others. Debbie Groulik has again added her Parade Sign-Up Sheet to the CIR website Calendar at: <a href="www.cirpca.org">www.cirpca.org</a>. Just click on the link above and login on the website and click on any of the Parade dates to enroll and add your name. This does not register you for the Parade; it just lets others in our region know you are going. We added everyone that we know is registered for our website, but there are a few who are not. Please let us know. There will be a PCA Zone 4 Party during Parade Week and CIR has donated to the party fund. Details will be later in a CIR Event Reminder.

#### **Latest Parade News**

So far, over 700 entrants are now registered for this year's Parade! This far exceeded their expectations for this date, compared to previous years. Many members are bringing 2 Porsches (new rule – both entrant and co-entrant can now bring a car). They have a record number of cars signed up for the Concours on Monday (June 24), probably due to the new "Street Class". The Grand Traverse Resort has booked all their hotel rooms and condos (600 total). They are encouraging couples to double up in some of the 2 & 3 bedroom condos to

save money and provide extra space to others. And they are now booking hotel rooms at the nearby new <u>Turtle Creek Casino & Hotel</u> (same owners) a couple miles east on Mich. 72. Rates are \$149/ Sun. - Thurs., \$179 Fri. - Sat.

Eight of the tours are now sold out, with wait lists. They have added five more of the most popular tours. There are another 13 tours that are not sold out. Additionally, they are asking people who are signed up for a sold out tour to sign up for another day, if possible, to provide spots for others.

Looking for another hotel? We recommend the <u>Tamarack Lodge</u> in Traverse City, just minutes west from the Grand Traverse Resort on US 31 at 877-938-9744. It is a fractional ownership type condominium that usually has units available for rent. It is built in quality arts and crafts style with contemporary lodge-type décor. Beautiful, fully deluxe equipped 1, 2 & 3 bedroom units have their own private beach and wetlands area at the bottom of the East Arm of Grand Traverse Bay. Call first to be put on their summer wait list.

More family oriented is the <a href="Cherry Tree Inn & Suites">Cherry Tree Inn & Suites</a> hotel next door 800-439-3093. It has the same beautiful beach with a very shallow walkout wetlands area. Nice rooms include complimentary hot breakfast in a very tight and hot breakfast room. We have stayed at both and like them. There are also many other hotels within just a few minutes of the Parade hotel in every price range.

# Recommended <u>Traverse City, Michigan</u> Area Tours

1. One of the most beautiful and scenic areas of our country, the Traverse City area has just about everything one could want in a vacation destination. If I had only one day to sight-see another area away from the Parade site, it would be <a href="Sleep-">Sleep-</a>



ing Bear Dunes National Lakeshore, about an hour west of Traverse City on M 72 – one of the most spectacular vistas in the U.S. Don't miss The Incline! And it's free for everyone in your car if you are 62 or older and have a National Parks Lifetime Senior Pass (available at any gate for \$10)! Best deal in America! While there, head on up to Glen Haven and check out the historic Sleeping Bear Point Coast Guard Station.


Then it's further north to Leland (Fishtown) for a wonderful Lake Superior Whitefish lunch or dinner. Brigitta and I recommend <a href="The Cove">The Cove</a> for its great food, drinks and view of the river and their unique fishing boats. On the way back to Traverse City, visit one of the many fine wineries on the Leelanau Peninsula. Stop in Suttons Bay for great shopping and check out the <a href="Tall Ship Manitou">Tall Ship Manitou</a> (AAA Gem!) docked for sightseeing tours at the bottom of the West Arm of Grand Traverse Bay. Plan a whole day for this trip!

- 2. Next choice would be the world famous five mile long Mackinac Suspension Bridge and Mackinac Island (six Parade tours can't be wrong!) at the tip of Lower Michigan. Be sure to rent a tandem bike and ride all the way around the island. The horse driven carriage tours and the old fort are also very worthwhile. Then there is the Grand Hotel. Those words tell it all. It's Grand everything about it! By the way, it's pronounced "Mackinaw", not "Mackinac" (it's an old Indian name). Tip: Go across the Mackinac Toll Bridge and take the ferry from St. Ignace to Mackinac Island. It's closer, faster and the crowds are much lighter than in Mackinaw City and you get to cross the bridge twice! Another full day trip.
- **3.** Want a beautiful drive with scenic Lake Michigan vistas and wonderful small towns with great shops and restaurants? Then head north on scenic US 31 to Charlevoix, Petoskey and Harbor

Springs! Stop at Stafford's famous Weathervane Restaurant in Charlevoix for a great lunch or dinner. If it's nice, sit out on the deck and watch the boats navigate the channel and lift bridge from Lake Michigan to Lake Charlevoix. The new Bay Harbor development comes up next on the left – a world class resort with everything to offer. In Petoskey the Gaslight Shopping District is well known for its shopping and restaurants, the best restaurant in the area is the historic Stafford's Bay View Inn, on the left on US 31. Pick up a Petoskey stone while in town. It's petrified coral from eons ago. Last is Harbor Springs, full of elegant shops, art galleries and fine eateries and another Stafford's Pier Restaurant on the marina. My favorite drive in all of Michigan is M 119 north out of Harbor Springs to Cross Village. If you are in this area, do not miss this beautiful winding, narrow sports car road. You won't forget it. And the most unique restaurant in all of Michigan is at its terminus – the famous Legs Inn on the left. You won't believe the huge Indian wood carvings inside and all the antlers on the ceiling. We strongly recommend the Hunter's Stew. A great day!

4. Don't have a full day? Then we recommend a driving tour of Old Mission Peninsula on M 37, located between the East and West Arms of Grand Traverse Bay. Be sure to also take Shore Road on the east shore or Peninsula Drive on the west shore to see all the beautiful homes and bay vistas. Stop at the Old Mission General Store for lunch (hard to find!). It's an all-in-one gourmet deli, general store, ice cream stand and antique emporium incased in one little building you will never forget and the food is very good! Venture on north to the Old Mission Point Lighthouse (setting for many weddings). On the way back, visit one of the many fine wineries located mainly in the center of the Peninsula. A leisurely half day adventure!

# Recommended Restaurants in Traverse City Area

Besides the ones mentioned above, the <u>Aerie Restaurant</u> on the 16<sup>th</sup> floor of the Grand Traverse Resort is first class all the way and the view of the East Arm of Grand Traverse Bay is the best in the area. Remember, you have two free nights – Monday and Thursday – to make plans for.

Downtown Traverse City is the very popular <a href="Philis on Front">Philis on Front</a> Street or any of the other fine restaurants and bars located on this street in the heart of Traverse City (a great evening's walk!). <a href="North Peak">North Peak</a> <a href="Brewing Company">Brewing Company</a>, just west of downtown on Front Street, is a fun place with great food, brews and entertainment.

There are also some very good restaurants hidden away on the Old Mission Peninsula and around the shores of the West Arm, such as the <u>Mission Table</u> Restaurant.

The Parade Hospitality Suite is located off the

lobby of the Grand Traverse Resort and is Parade Central for everything that is going on at the Parade.

#### Weather and What to Pack

The weather in northern Michigan is usually dry and sunny during June with occasional rain. They do have cool nights sometimes up there, so be sure to pack some light sweaters or sweatshirts and a jacket for possible cool evenings. The hu-

midity is much lower than Indiana and if it's clear when the sun goes down, the temperature can drop. Because of the brilliant sunshine during the day, hats are a must along with sunscreen. And bring some comfortable walking shoes, because you are going to want to walk a lot - there's so much to see!

One last thing: If you only have one day to attend the Parade, I would go



on Monday for the Concours d'Elegance. There should be over 200 pristine Porsches on display along with many historic race cars from various museums, all displayed on the beautiful Spruce Run Golf Course with the Grand Traverse Resort in the background. You don't have to register, just drive up and spectate and don't forget your camera!

Well, that's all I can think of and we hope to see everyone in Traverse City! You'll have a great time!
