French Lick Porsche Parade News from Bob Snider

I hope everyone got to register for this year's **60th Porsche Parade** in French Lick on June 21-27 at www.pca.org. It was challenging to say the least. PCA National and Parade Staff are keenly aware of the problems with the website and have promised the site and Parade Registration will be drastically modified and simplified next year.

Randy Faunce and I attended the PCA Zone 4 President's Meeting in Toledo in March. Several PCA National officers were present, including Past PCA President Manny Alban of Maryland, PCA Treasurer Aaron Ambosino of New York, new PCA Zone 3 Rep Vic Rola of Tennessee and Parade Facilities Chair Francie Kish of Michigan along with our own PCA Zone 4 Rep Michael Soriano. We also had two executives of the French Lick Resort attend and gave a video and verbal presentation on this year's Parade.

Here are some interesting facts: PCA National and Parade Staff wholly underestimated the unprecedented early interest in this Parade. They didn't know there would be so much interest. The contract for this Parade was signed in 2009 and it is nearly impossible to estimate attendance for a Parade that far in advance. The Parade Staff and PCA National estimate and then sign irrevocable contracts years in advance. It's a guessing game. The current Parade Facilities Chair has been handling Parade hotels and banquet space since 2009 (seven Parades) and was overall Parade Chair of the very successful 1989 Traverse City, Michigan Porsche Parade.

This Parade is breaking records left and right. All blocked hotel rooms at both resorts were gone in just 20 hours! They are now booking additional hotels in French Lick and Jasper (½ hour south). French Lick personnel are calling hotel wait list registrants and providing them with rooms at these hotels; 657 rooms are booked at both resorts during the peak days of the Parade. This is near capacity. The average stay is 4 ½ days, which is much better than normal. French Lick surpassed the highly successful and praised 2013 Traverse City Parade on June 21 with 872 cars registered in just four days and still counting! The Indianapolis Motor Speedway Driving Tours are sold out with 195 cars registered (45 on wait list) for June 23 and over 150 cars for June 24. The Patoka Lake Dinner Cruise also sold out.

Cook Medical Group in Bloomington has invested over \$600 million in the restoration and additional facilities at the French Lick and West Baden Resorts. 300 people signed up for Mrs. Gayle Cook's "Domes of the World" presentation on June 22, during the Concours.



She is normally used to only about 30 to 40 people attending her talks. It is probably going to be moved to the West Baden Atrium and they don't quite yet know how to tell her how many registered!

There will be a CIR Parade Welcome Dinner on Monday, June 22 at Hagen's Club House Restaurant at the Donald Ross Golf Course south of French Lick on Indiana 56, starting at 6 PM with a Cocktail Reception and Dinner at 7 PM. Order from their diverse menu, separate checks arranged with gratuity added. This immediately follows the Concours d'Elegance and will be a great way to meet all your CIR friends and it is a Parade Free Night with no banquets planned.

Thursday, June 25 will be the PCA Zone 4 Party (we are all members of PCA Zone 4) in The Pavilion at the spectacular Pete Dye Golf Course on top of Mt. Arie from 5 - 7 PM. Tom Wood Porsche in Indianapolis had agreed to sponsor this party and the French Lick Resort will also support this event - if we surpass the Zone 4 registration at the Traverse City Parade (541 cars). There will be a Zone 4 Party Trophy awarded to the Region (there are 12 in Zone 4) with the most percentage attendance at the party, based on each region's size. T-shirts are being made promoting the party and will be distributed to all 12 regions.

PCA National and Parade Staff are going all out for this 60th Porsche Parade. There will be a "60 4 60" Historic Display covering 60 years of representative Porsches from every year and model on display during the Parade. The Concours will have the greatest Historical Display of any Porsche Parade to date with the Porsche factory sending 4 to 5 cars from the Porsche Museum, the Ingram Porsche Collection in North Carolina shipping a trailer full of cars and many former Parade Manhattan Trophy winners will be on display. The PCA Museum of "60 years of PCA" will also be available during Parade Week with artifacts from previous Parades and the PCA Archives. A Parade not to be missed!

Brigitta and I, along with all of our hard-working CIR officers and chairpersons look forward to seeing you at this French Lick Porsche Parade!





Teen Driver Emergency Car Control Clinic

INDIANAPOLIS - Congratulations on your (or your child's) passing of the Indiana BMV exams to earn your driver's license! It means you know enough of the 'rules of the road' (use of signals, road signs, which lane to be in, 4-way stops, etc.) to NOT be a hazard to the others on the road with you. A couple questions for you: do you know what the foot pedal is supposed to feel like on really hard braking? Can you keep your car from spinning into a tree if you have to suddenly swerve around an obstacle? On wet pavement?

Franklin Central High School 6215 South Franklin Road Indianapolis, IN 46239 We're hosting a Car Control Clinic, specifically designed for newer drivers (age 21 and under), to share the knowledge (classroom) and experience (driving drills) needed to enhance safety during emergency driving maneuvers (skills not taught in traditional driver's education). It's NOT about speed (no helmets), or timed performance (no trophies), or 'drifting', or... It's an open parking lot, with traffic cones, specifically set up to experience an emergency lane change, or skidding on wet pavement, or what to do on a brake-and-turn (and what NOT to do, too).

The drills will be performed in the student driver's daily driven car, with an experienced instructor in the passenger seat, offering driving tips and techniques that are reinforced during the classroom sessions.

The program was developed by Street Survival, an independent foundation established for the purpose of teen driving safety enhancement. The core of the lessons taught, the take-home booklets, powerpoint presentation. were designed by specialized staff of this foundation.

The Tire Rack, Michelin, Enterprise Car Rentals, Indiana Farmers Mutual Insurance and other corporations and private donors, provide the funding needed to keep the program current, and supply materials and support to the schools being hosted around the country.


